## TIPS FOR LANGUAGE LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

Entering the toddler phase is an exciting time! Typically when children turn two years old, they already have about 50-200 words in their vocabulary! But what if your child doesn't? What if they haven't even said their first word?

### Language Delay:

- Language develops in typical sequence, but lags behind peers

### Language Disorder

- Atypical language acquisition
- Disrupts communication across settings

### Sabotaging the environment

The word sabotaging may sound a bit odd, but it is a great technique to increase language learning opportunities! All you're doing is setting up a play situation/activity so that your child will need your help. Here are some easy ways to try it in your home:

- Place toys/games/books in bins with lids
- Place toys/games/books on shelves your kiddo can't reach
- Set up puzzle pieces, magnetic tiles, or Legos just out of your child's reach during playtime
